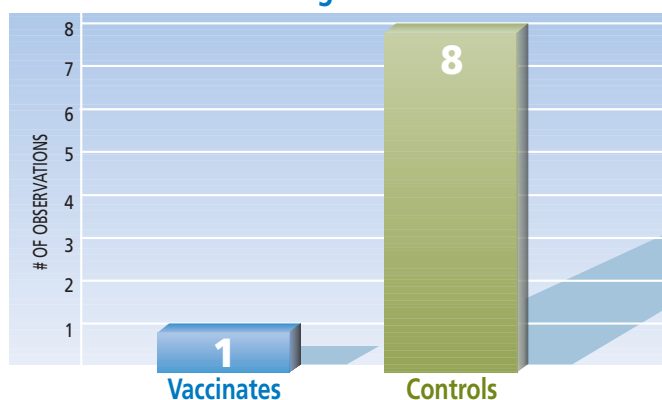

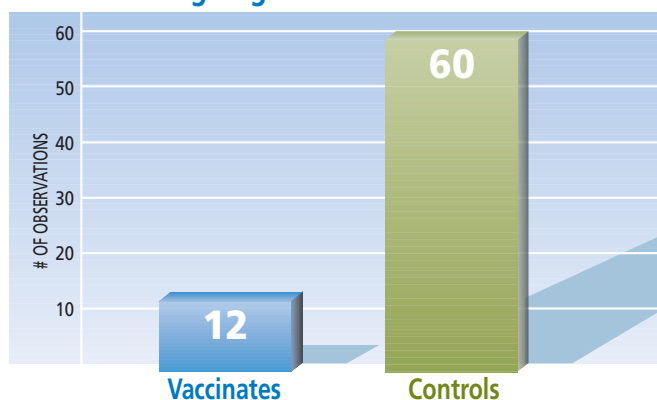

Fluvac Innovator vaccinates had > 50 percent reduction in mean clinical scores compared to controls.

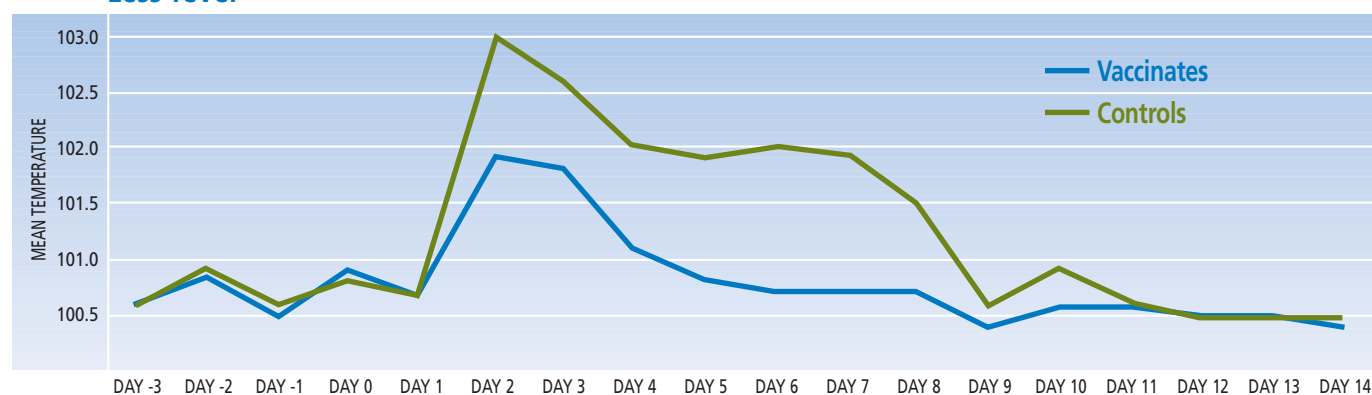
Less viral shedding

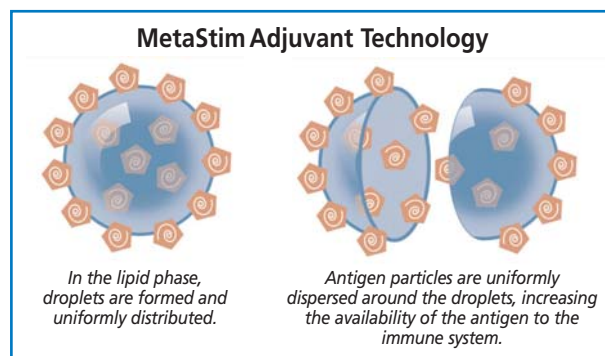
